

Next Level Jobs Employer Training Grant - OPEN!

Indiana Department of Workforce Development has announced that the application for Employer Training Grant/Reimbursement, or "ETG 6.0", is set to open Thursday, September 1, 2022. The application can be found in the employer portal - if you do not already have credentials to sign into the portal, an Indiana SUTA (State Unemployment Tax Authorization) number IS a required field on the application this year. If you do not know what this number is, please speak with your accounting department or the individual that processes premium payments for unemployment insurance to Indiana Department of Workforce Development.

This year, 25% of the regions allocation will be set aside for new employers or employers that have not benefited from the grant in previous years.

ETG 6.0 will be different from previous years in the following ways:

- The Employer reimbursement amount will be based upon the actual cost of the training and the type of training provided:
 Up to \$5,000 per employee for training resulting in post-secondary
 - Up to \$3,000 per employee for specialty company training
 Up to \$3,000 per employee for specialty company training
 Up to \$1000 per high school student enrolled in a work-based learning

 - program
 - New Employees must be receiving a minimum wage of \$17 per hour, and exisiting employees must receive a minimum 3% wage increase.

All other previous training/trainee requirements will remain in place.


